



Chief Advisor Directs to Ensure Transparency and Public Visibility in July Charter Process

Chief Advisor and Chairman of the National Consensus Commission, Professor Muhammad Yunus, has directed that the work of the commission be carried out transparently and made visible to the public. He gave this directive during a meeting of the commission held on Thursday (July 17) at the state guest house, Jamuna.

The meeting was attended by Vice-Chairman of the Commission, Professor Dr. Ali Riaz, members Dr. Badiul Alam Majumdar, Dr. Iftekharuzzaman, Safar Raj Hossain, Justice Emdadul Haque, and Dr. Mohammad Ayub Miah. Also present were the Chief Advisor's Principal Secretary Siraj Uddin Miah and Special Assistant Monir Hayder.

Commission members briefed the Chief Advisor on the progress of the commission's work. They informed him that all efforts are being made to finalize the July Charter by August 5.

Commending the members, the Chief Advisor said, "This is a historic initiative. The charter will reflect the aspirations of the people. Therefore, the entire process must be transparent and open to the public."

Vice-Chairman of the Commission, Professor Dr. Ali Riaz, stated that consensus has already been reached on eight issues during the second round of dialogue with political parties. Discussions are ongoing on the remaining seven issues, and it is hoped that agreement will be reached on those soon as well.
