



US says it shot down Iranian drones in Strait of Hormuz

The United States has claimed that it intercepted and destroyed multiple Iranian drones that were allegedly targeting commercial vessels passing through the Strait of Hormuz. The information was confirmed by the US Central Command (CENTCOM).

According to a report by Al Jazeera, CENTCOM said in a post on X that Iran had launched several one-way attack drones toward the strait during an hours-long operation.

The US military stated that all incoming drones were successfully neutralized, adding that shipping through the Strait of Hormuz remains normal and has not been disrupted.

CENTCOM further said that the strategically vital waterway for global trade remains fully open, with no impact on maritime traffic.
