



IAEA's Role in Nuclear Facility Attacks Questioned: Tehran

Tehran has accused the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) of failing to take a clear stance on the reported attacks by the United States and Israel on Iran's nuclear facilities. Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesperson Esmail Baghaei described the agency's silence as questionable.

In an interview with the state-run Tasnim News Agency, Baghaei said that the attacks by the United States and Israel are a clear violation of international law. However, he added that the IAEA's silence on the matter is further complicating the situation.

He also criticized IAEA Director General Rafael Grossi, claiming that instead of condemning the attacks, Grossi has made remarks that are contributing to escalating tensions.

Such accusations from Iran are not new, but amid rising regional tensions, the issue has once again drawn international attention.
