



Injured July uprising protesters stage sit-in before Chief Adviser's Office



People injured during the July uprising on Wednesday gathered in front of the office of the interim government's chief adviser, Dr Muhammad Yunus. They marched to the Chief Adviser's Office in Tejgaon, Dhaka, and staged a sit-in on the road, chanting slogans demanding appropriate compensation and sufficient support.
