



Trump warns Iran of severe situation without deal

US President Donald Trump has warned that Iran could face a difficult situation if a quick agreement is not reached. He made the remarks in an interview with French media outlet BFMTV.

Trump said Iran must face serious consequences if it fails to reach a settlement over its nuclear program. At the same time, he noted that reaching a deal would be in the interest of both sides.

Meanwhile, Iranian Parliament Speaker Mohammad Bagher Ghalibaf claimed that the world is moving toward a new international order. Tehran has also announced plans for new regulations in the Strait of Hormuz, which may include toll collection for vessels passing through.

Iran further stated that “hostile countries” will not be allowed to transport weapons through the strait. On the other hand, the US military claims that amid rising tensions, the movement of 78 commercial vessels has been disrupted at various Iranian ports, and four ships have been disabled.
