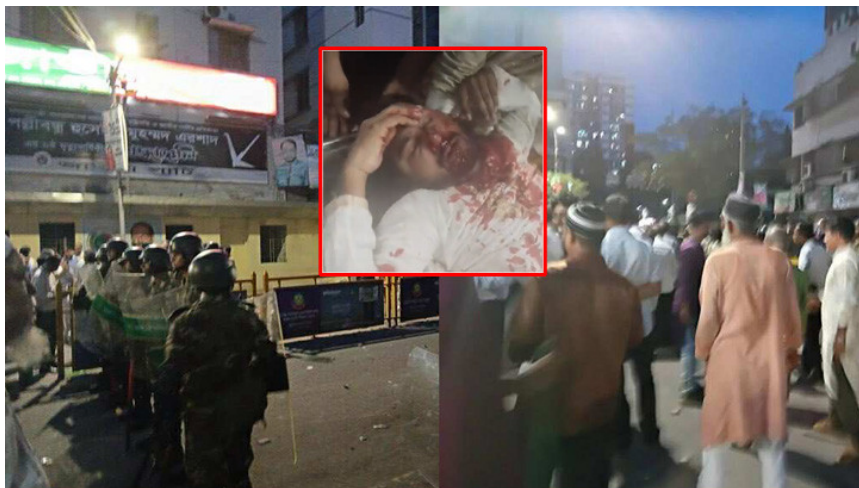




Clashes in Front of Jatiya Party Office, Gonodhikar Parishad's Nurul Haque Nur Seriously Injured

Tensions flared in front of the Jatiya Party (JaPa) headquarters on Friday night, leading to a violent clash in which Gonodhikar Parishad president Nurul Haque Nur was brutally injured. His colleagues rushed him to the hospital in critical condition, sparking concern among his supporters and well-wishers.

Eyewitnesses reported that around 8:15 pm, Gonodhikar leaders gathered peacefully for the second time that evening near the JaPa office. What began as a demonstration soon escalated into chaos as JaPa activists confronted them, triggering a chase and counter-chase.

In an attempt to control the situation, police and members of the Bangladesh Army jointly intervened. Instead of calming tensions, however, the joint forces issued an ultimatum and then carried out a forceful baton charge when Gonodhikar activists did not disperse immediately.

During this indiscriminate crackdown, Nurul Haque Nur, a key voice of the movement and a symbol of resistance for many young Bangladeshis, suffered severe injuries along with several of his party colleagues. Witnesses described the attack as excessive and unnecessary, leaving many shocked at the level of force used against political activists.

The incident has raised deep concerns about the treatment of opposition leaders and the future of democratic expression in Bangladesh.
