



Iran Allows Emergency Shipping Through Strait of Hormuz

Iran has announced that it will allow vessels carrying essential goods and humanitarian supplies to pass through the Strait of Hormuz. According to state media, the key maritime route will not be fully closed, and limited passage will remain available for such shipments.

Shipping activity through the strategically important waterway, which is under Iranian control, has significantly declined in recent days, putting pressure on global energy supplies and international trade.

Several countries are pursuing diplomatic efforts to ensure safe navigation in the region, while a limited number of commercial vessels continue to operate.

Earlier, Iran stated that ships not affiliated with the United States, Israel, or their close allies may be permitted to use the strait.
