



Mohammed Yunus received an honorary doctorate degree from Chinese University



The chief adviser to the interim government received an honorary doctorate degree from Peking University, China. Muhammad Yunus, Bangladesh's chief adviser was awarded an honorary doctorate degree at a function organized at the University Conference Hall on Saturday (March 27)

Speaking on the occasion, Professor Yunus said that the transparency and transparency of the new Bangladesh will be guaranteed and the release of hunger and poverty will be priority.
