



## Jamaat Announces Two-Day Program for Five-Point Demands

Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami has announced a two-day program to push for the implementation of its five-point public demands. On October 10, the party will hold rallies across the country, and on October 12, it will submit memorandums to the district commissioners. The party's Secretary General, Professor Mia Golam Parwar, urged the government to implement these demands.

Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami has unveiled a new program aimed at securing the implementation of its five-point public demands. The announced activities include nationwide rallies on Friday, October 10, and submission of memorandums to all district commissioners on Sunday, October 12.

In a statement on Wednesday, October 8, Jamaat Secretary General Professor Mia Golam Parwar called for the successful execution of these programs. He said, "We have always demanded a free, fair, impartial, and fearless environment for a credible national election. However, if the government ignores the five-point public demands announced by Jamaat-e-Islami, the people will be compelled to intensify their movement to secure their rightful rights."

He further added that, as part of the second phase, rallies will be held in the capital and all divisional cities, followed by the submission of memorandums to each district commissioner's office.
