Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir said, "You (students) will form a party. We will welcome you, cooperate with you. We will work shoulder to shoulder to hold a free and fair election."

He, however, requested to them (students) not to utter derogatory remarks, saying "I will only make this request to you that it would be better not to bring any unnecessary conflicting talk into politics, we hope so (to you)."

He further said that today she (Hasina) is gone and it have paved the way to talk peacefully, adding, "Now, we're free from Hasina. But our goal is to return to a democratic system, but so far we have not been able to return to that democracy."

The BNP secretary general said the present government is an interim government and they have been clearly told their responsibilities as Hasina has created so much mess, and destroyed the country's economy, judicial system and the administration.

"They (incumbent government) will hold elections by fixing these to a minimum level through reform . . . and at the election, people will vote and bring someone to power those they want," he added.
