



Israeli strike kills 5 at Gaza wedding

At least five people have been killed in an Israeli airstrike on a wedding ceremony in Gaza City, according to reports.

Qatar-based media outlet Al Jazeera said the death toll may rise further.

The report said two missiles were fired at a makeshift tent during the celebration. Panic spread immediately after the strike, leaving many people dead and injured.

Al Jazeera correspondent Hani Mahmoud reported that a significant number of people were also wounded, with fears that others may still be trapped under the rubble.

Details about the exact location and timing of the attack were not immediately confirmed.

A source at Al-Shifa Hospital said at least a dozen people were injured in the incident, with victims receiving treatment in hospital.
