



## Protests against Donald Trump across the United States



Protests have been held in five states of the country against US President Donald Trump. The protests took place in protest of Trump's agenda in the social and economic fields

"We are fighting for democracy and the constitution," Democrat party Congress member Elhan Omar said. I am fighting for the desired future of my family. President Trump wants to be autocratic. I will not accept any autocratic in America. A wealthy president bought the seat next to the president and made him a doll. But American democracy is not for sale and it will not.

Al Green, another Congress member of the Democrat party, said President Trump might not be able to complete the term this time. We will propose a prosecution against Trump within 5 days.
