



BNP on the Path to a Broad Electoral Alliance: Salahuddin Ahmed

BNP is planning to form a broad electoral alliance ahead of the upcoming national election, said the party's Standing Committee member Salahuddin Ahmed. He stated that initiatives are underway to build a united front comprising political parties involved in the anti-fascist movement.

Speaking to reporters on Monday (October 27), after paying tribute at the grave of BNP's founder and former President Ziaur Rahman on the occasion of the 47th founding anniversary of Jatiyatabadi Jubo Dal, Salahuddin Ahmed made these remarks.
