



Post-Eid return ticket sales to start on March 24

Each passenger will be allowed to purchase advance tickets only once, with a maximum of four seats Bangladesh Railway will begin selling advance tickets for post-Eid return train journeys on March 24. The information was shared by Bangladesh Railway Director General Md Afzal Hossain during an inter-ministerial meeting held at Bidyut Bhaban in Dhaka on Sunday afternoon. As in previous years, intercity train tickets will be sold under a special arrangement, with 100% of the tickets available online for the convenience of passengers. According to Bangladesh Railway's decision,

Additionally, based on moon sighting, tickets for March 31, April 1, and April 2 may also be sold Bangladesh Railway further announced that, upon passengers' request, 25% of the tickets will be available from the departure station before the journey begins. As in previous years, intercity train tickets will be sold under a special arrangement, with 100% of the tickets available online for the convenience of passengers.
