



Bangladesh strongly condemned the genocide of Israeli forces in Gaza



Calling the international community, especially the United Nations, the Bangladesh government has said that they should take effective steps immediately

Bangladesh has strongly condemned the ongoing genocide and human rights violations by Israeli occupation forces in Gaza, Palestine. The Foreign Ministry's statement was condemned on Monday (April 7th).

It is stated that the Israeli military attack has been killed in many Palestinians since the ceasefire violation, most of them women and children. As a result, humanitarian assistance in Gaza has stopped, which has pushed to humanitarian disaster. Obviously Israel has repeatedly made the international appeal but has been involved in the growing murder.

Bangladesh strongly condemns the indiscriminate bombing of Israeli occupation forces in densely populated civilian areas of Gaza to launch a racial elimination campaign against the unarmed Palestinian population. The Government of Bangladesh is calling for Israel to stop all military operations immediately, show maximum restraint and perform its duties under international humanitarian law.

The statement also said that the Bangladesh government, especially the UN, said that they should take effective steps immediately, so that the lives of the people of Gaza can be saved and humanitarian assistance is properly managed.

According to the statement, the government of Bangladesh is reiterating the need to return to the discussion platform for lasting peace in the Middle East, which is very important for regional and global stability. Bangladesh has urged all concerned to commit themselves in the way of diplomacy and dialogue to end violence and misery against the Palestinian people.

Bangladesh is urging the world community to work towards a two-state solution on the basis of the aspirations of international law, UN proposals and the aspirations of Palestinians for peace, dignity and justice
