According to the BSF Tripura Frontier, Roni was accompanied by a woman.

The security forces first saw the duo approaching the border fence from the Bangladesh side. Despite multiple warnings from the officials, they attempted to breach the fencing and engaged in a fight with the security guards. The two even tried to snatch one of the official's Pump Action Gun (PAG), officials said.an act of self-defence and following the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), the security official fired a single round at the duo.

While the man was injured, the woman managed to run to a nearby village. The man was taken to the GBP Hospital in Agartala, where he is currently undergoing treatment, officials said.
